EH&S Update – Mary Meyer

- Safety Performance Update for LAO
 - The site is 53 days injury free.
 - Recently completed the Poly D turnaround.
 - Glycol 2 turnaround is ongoing and there has been no incidents. Everything is moving smoothly and on track to end in two to three weeks.
- Groundwater Update
 - Remediation team met and the first quarter ground water sampling results were mailed to CAP members. The second quarter sampling has been completed and will be mailed to members soon. There are no major changes or concerns.

Site and IPark Updates – Eleanor Joffrion and Crystal King

Eleanor Joffrion

- There are large modulators being moved next week and through June. Large scale buildings and pipe racks are moving through from Texas and planned to come down river road and through Gate 11.
- IPark tenant Ineos is in a turnaround.
- Olin will be in a turnaround in the late third quarter, into the fourth. There may be some traffic increase.
- Glycol 1 will have a month-long turnaround in September.
- Eleanor is meeting with tenants to prepare for hurricane season and ensure preparations are in place before, during, and after the event.

Crystal King

- Seadrift site was selected for the Dow and X energy advanced small modular reactor nuclear project.
- Linde Gas is partnering with Dow on a net-zero Carbon emissions integrated Ethylene cracker in Canada.
- There are no projects with carbon sequestration locally at Dow planned.

- Safety Day in Iberville Parish planning to include wildlife fisheries, Acadian Ambulance, fire dept, law enforcement, industry, red cross, etc. Slated for March 16, 2024.
- WBR Masterplan update ongoing with Jason Manola.
- WBR Chamber is working on new certified sites in WBR through LED – goal to have 2 certified sites.
